For our city to be a healthy and happy place to live, the voices of ALL its residents need to be heard. In your hand you have an important tool to make sure that happens!

The Seattle City Council seats recently changed so that the majority (7 of 9) correspond to geographic districts. The districts are based on population census tracts.

This was done to make the council more accountable. So give them a call!

In 2015, all 9 council seats were up for election in order to transition to the current district system. Councilmembers have 4yr terms, with the exception of the current citywide or "at-large" councilmembers. Tim Burgess (Position 8) & M. Lorena Gonzalez (Position 9) were elected to 2yr terms. In 2017 these 2 seats will be elected to 4yr terms. The at-large council positions will from then on be on the same election cycle as the mayor & city attorney.
